How to register:

1. Go online to www.collegeboard.com
2. Fill in name
3. Screen for high school information, select United States, US territories, Puerto Rico – **Not Outside US**
4. Enter High School - 577060
5. Mailing Address Screen – Select United States, US territories, Puerto Rico – **Not Outside US**
(Overseas phone numbers are not accepted. If you do not have a stateside phone number, do not input anything. A phone number is not required to complete registration.)
6. Fill in Profile Questions
7. Register for test screen: select taking test Outside US (IMPORTANT)
8. Select search by school name or code: Select I know the test center code
9. Enter Testing center Code: 58366
10. Our school is called Naples High School
11. Follow instructions regarding photo needed for admission ticket
12. You may select up to 4 colleges to send your scores for free.

On day of SAT, students must arrive NLT **7:30 AM** with an approved College Board calculator, DOD/NATO ID, and official registration ticket with their photo from the online registration.

Students without proper identification and late comers will not be admitted.

Students are responsible for registering for the SAT/ACT tests. Counselors or Coordinators do not register students or make payments. Our recommendation at Naples High School is for sophomores who score 50 or above in all subjects on the PSAT test take the SAT beginning January of their sophomore year. 1. Get **International Fee Waiver** form from in the main office.
2. Go online to www.actstudent.org
3. Select sign up/log in - you must create an account if you do not have one.
4. CREATE A USERNAME AND PASSWORD – KEEP IT IN A SAFE PLACE.
5. Select country: United States
6. Input PSC address
7. Select state: Armed Forces Europe
8. Use only the first 5 digits in the zip code. (Plus 4 is not allowed)
9. Input 999-999-9999 for phone number.
10. Fill in Personal Profile
11. Test Selection: Choose In Another Country
12. Choose ACT with writing test
13. You High School screen : Enter HS code: 577060 NAPLES AMERICAN HS DOD
14. Score Report Choices – you may chose up to 4 schools for free.
15. Test Center Screen: Enter 866820 NAPLES AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL
16. On payment page, enter waiver number
