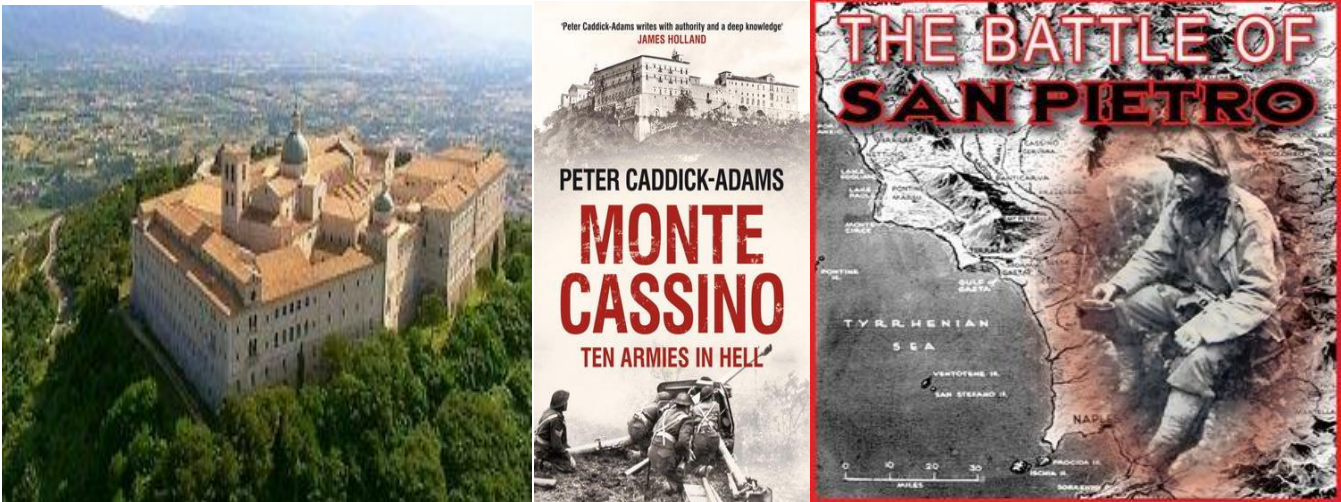


U.S. History Field Trip to Monte Cassino and San Pietro Infini

Students attending this field trip will be learning about World War II history here in Italy. The American military fought fierce battles at both sites against the German Army. Our first stop is the Battle of Monte Cassino to visit the Abbey and also the siege lines and battle sites. Next we will tour the ruins of the town of San Pietro Infini (yes, the entire town is still in ruins) and their WWII museum. English guides to both sites.
